Applications in prescribed form are invited from intending candidates of Keonjhar District for filling up the following categories of posts in the High Schools /Girls' High Schools under ST&SC Development Department of Keonjhar District on Contractual Basis. In case of non-availability of suitable candidates from Keonjhar District, applications of the candidates from other Districts will be considered. But the posts of "Junior Clerk" and "Peon" are meant for the candidates belonging to Keonjhar District only.

General eligibility:-

- He /She must be a citizen of India.
- (i) He/ She must have passed the High School Certificate or an equivalent or any Higher Examination with Odia as a language subject or
(ii) He/ She must have Odia as a medium, of examination in non-language subject at the High School Certificate or equivalent examination , which He/ She have passed.
- Candidates having Bachelor Degree in Arts / Commerce / Science with Bachelor Degree in Education from any University of the State or its equivalency are eligible. Regarding Universities / Institutions of outside State , the candidates shall only be eligible for engagement after verification of genuineness of their educational / training qualification from concerned University / Institution form which they have obtained the Degree .
- Such outside University / Institution pass out candidates shall have to produce the authenticated proof of equivalency and NCTE recognition in support of their qualification at the time of verification failing which their case will not be entertained.
- He/ She must not have more than one spouse living.

1. Age:-

For the post of Teachers & Junior Clerk

He / She must be below 32 Yrs. and above 21 Yrs. of age as on 01.03.2018 provided that maximum age limit shall be relaxed by 05 Years in case of candidates belong to the ST,SC,SEBC & Woman candidates. Age shall be relaxed for Ex-Service man as per Odisha Ex-Service Man Rule,1989. In case of PH candidate the upper age shall be relaxed by 10 years.

For the post of Peon

He / She must be below 32 Yrs. and above 18 Yrs. of age as on 01.03.2018 provided that maximum age limit shall be relaxed by 05 Years in case of candidates belong to the ST,SC,SEBC & Woman candidates. Age shall be relaxed for Ex-Service man as per Odisha Ex-Service Man Rule,1989. In case of PH candidate the upper age shall be relaxed by 10 years.

2. Educational Qualification

- BA.BEd. Teacher** - He / She must have obtained bachelor degree in Arts/ Commerce (with two school subjects) from a recognised university with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/OBC/SEBC candidates) alongwith a degree in Bachelor in Education (a course prescribed by NCTE) from an institution recognised by NCTE and affiliated to a recognised university.

- (b) **BSc.BEd. Teacher** - He / She must have obtained bachelor degree in Science (CBZ/PCM) (with two school subjects) from a recognised University with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/OBC/SEBC candidates) along with a Degree in Bachelor in Education (a course prescribed by NCTE) from an institution recognised by NCTE and affiliated to a recognised University.
- (c) **Sanskrit Teacher** – Bachelor Degree with Sanskrit as one of the optional/ Hons. subject from a recognised University with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/OBC/SEBC candidates) with Sikshya Shastri (Sanskrit) (a course prescribed by NCTE) from a recognised University / Institution recognised by NCTE and affiliated to a recognised University

OR

Shastri (Sanskrit) with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/OBC/SEBC candidates) from recognised University and Sikshya Shastri (Sanskrit) (a course prescribed by NCTE) from a recognised University / Institution recognised by NCTE and affiliated to a recognised University.

OR

Acharya (Except Jyotishacharya and Ayurvedacharya) or Sahityacharya with minimum 50% marks in aggregate from a recognised University.

OR

Bachelor's Degree with Sanskrit as one of the optional/ Hons. subject with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/OBC/SEBC candidates) and M.A in Sanskrit with minimum 50% marks in aggregate from a recognised University.

In case trained candidates are not available, untrained candidates shall be engaged.
(The untrained candidates shall have to undergo required training within the time line as prescribed by Govt.)

- (d) **Hindi Teacher**- Bachelor's Degree from a recognised University with Hindi as one of the elective subject with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/OBC/SEBC candidates) or with Rastrabhasa Ratna from Rastrabhasa Prachar Samiti , Wardha or with Sastri from Odisha Rastrabhasa Parisada, Puri or with Snataka (Acquired by June,2005, the date up to which the temporary recognition has been granted) from Hindi Sikshya Samiti , Odisha, Cuttack or an equivalent Degree from a recognised institution with at least 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/OBC/SEBC candidates) and Hindi Sikshyan Parangat from Kendriya Hindi Sansthan, Agra/ B.H.Ed. (a course prescribed by NCTE) from a Institution recognised by NCTE and affiliated to a recognised University/ BEd. in Hindi (a course prescribed by NCTE) from Dakhin Bharat Hindi Prachar Sabha, Madras, a institution recognised by NCTE and affiliated to a recognised University.

OR

Bachelor's Degree with Hindi as one of the optional / Hons. subject with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/OBC/SEBC candidates) and M.A. in Hindi with minimum 50% marks in aggregate from a recognised University.

In case trained candidates are not available, untrained candidates shall be engaged.
(The untrained candidates shall have to undergo required training within the time line as prescribed by Govt.)

- (e) **PET**- Matric or its equivalent examination with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/ OBC/ SEBC candidates) and CPed from recognised Board/ University.

(For the post of BA.BEd./BSc.BEd./Sanskrit Teacher/ Hindi Teacher/PET the candidates must have to pass OSSSTET conducted by BSE, Odisha within the prescribed timeline)

- (f) **ISc.CT-** He / She must have passed C.T. with Intermediate/+2 of Science with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/ PH/ OBC/ SEBC candidates)from a recognised Council with OTET.
- (g) **IA.CT-** He / She must have passed C.T. with Intermediate/+2 of Arts with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/ PH/ OBC/ SEBC candidates)from a recognised Council with OTET.
- (h) **Junior Clerk :-** He / She must have passed Graduation or equivalent examination from a recognised University as per G.A. Deptt. Resolution No.27367/Gen./Dtd.29.11.2017 with basic computer knowledge.
- (i) **Peon-** He / She must have passed M.E. Examination.

The B.Ed./B.H.Ed./ Sikshya Sashtri candidates should have registered their names either in the Employment Bureau located at Vanivihar, Bhubaneswar/ Jyoti Vihar, Sambalpur/ Bhanja Vihar, Berhampur/ OUAT, Bhubanswar or in the State Employment Exchange, Bhubaneswar or in any District Employment Exchange. The candidates for PET/ Classical/ Hindi teachers/ IA/ISc.CT/ Junior Clerk / Peon should have registered their names in the Employment Exchange located in the concerned Revenue District which he/ she belongs to / State Employment Exchange. SC/ST and PH candidates should have registered their name in the Special Employment Exchange for SC/ST & PH at Bhubaneswar or in any Employment Exchange located in the concerned Revenue District which he/ she belong to.

3. Reservation:-

The Odisha Reservation of Vacancies (In posts and services for ST&SC) Act.,1975 and The Odisha Reservation of Posts & Services for Socially & Educationally Backward Classes Act,2008 and the rules made there under and such other principles of the post based reservation as prescribed by the State Government on the land mark judgement of Hon'ble High Court/ Supreme Court , from time to time , shall be followed.

One third of the notified vacancies will be reserved for Women Candidates of respective categories. Similarly 4% will be reserved for Physically Handicapped as per the provision of Section-33 of the " Persons with disabilities" (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation Act), 1% for eminent sports personnel and 3% for Ex-serviceman.

Instructions contained in SSEPD Deptt. Resolution No.7140/Dtd.05.09.2017 shall be adhered to , for (PwDs). candidates.

The PH candidates shall be referred to the Appellate Medical Board constituted by W&CD Department vide Notification No.16430/WCD/Dtd.06.09.2011 for re-examination. Engagement order shall be issued if such candidates found genuine by the Board.

4. Emoluments & Service condition:-

The emoluments and service conditions shall be guided as per the provisions of G.A Deptt. Notification No.32010/Gen./Dtd.12.11.2013 & No.19569/Gen./Dtd.12.09.2017 & No.19574/Gen./Dtd.12.09.2017.
